Ingredient list:

2 oz Blanco Tequila
1 oz Cointreau
1 oz Fresh Lime Juice

Process:

Combine all ingredients in a shaker and add ice. Shake and strain into a salt-rimmed rocks glass. Garnish with a lime wheel, enjoy!
