

## **AGUA DE VALENCIA**

Known as “Valencia Water” this cocktail’s name points to its area of origin, Valencia, Spain, known for producing world-famous oranges (and the birthplace of Paella). It’s believed the first version of this cocktail was made in 1959 at a bar called Café Madrid de Valencia. The cocktail gained popularity in the 1970s, when it became more well-known in the city.

### **Serving: 1**

#### **Ingredient list:**

A pitcher  
500 ml Fresh-Squeezed Valencia Orange Juice  
300 ml Cava  
100 ml Gin  
100 ml Vodka  
A spoon of Sugar to taste

#### **Process:**

1. Add the orange juice, vodka, gin, sugar and fruit to a kitchen. Stir well.
2. Fill glasses with ice and pour over the cocktail.
3. To finish, top up each glass with sparkling wine.

Cocktail Note: This recipe would have originally used local oranges from Valencia where it was created, but any orange juice will work. The sweeter the better.



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
